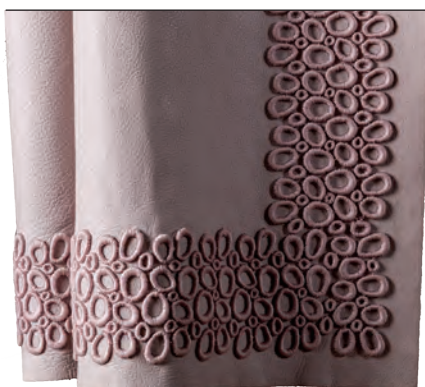

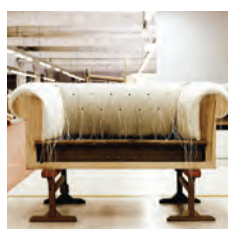

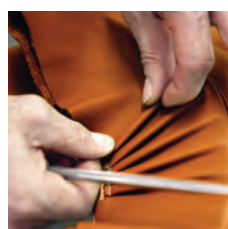
Stitched patterns enhance the tactile and opulent qualities of leather. The prevalence of this trend needs no embellishment.
